- 3. Jerry Coleman, B/M, Parker's neighbor, Coleman gave this typed and recorded interview on 8/15/97
 - Det. Williams- Hello Mr. coleman we asked you here today to ask you a few questions about the death of Angela Parker.
 - Williams- Do you know any thing about the night Angela was killed?
 - Coleman- On that night, I was standing out in my driveway which is across the street from Angela's and I saw and this guy name Ronnie.

Williams- Ronnie who?

- Coleman- I don't know his last name but he out front of Angela's house talking to her, when her friend connie came to the door and Angela went in the house and about 15 minutes later she returned and then started talking to Ronnie again
- Williams- How far is your house from the spot where they're standing in her yard?
- Coleman- I'll say about 40 yards.
- Williams- Could you see what they were wearing especially Johnson?
- Coleman- He was wearing some black shorts and a white Bulls T-shirt, and white tennis shoes.
- Williams- What time was it then?
- Coleman- Around 2:20, 2:25am.
- Williams- Then what happened then?
- Coleman- They talked for a few more minutes and Ronnie got in his truck and drove away.
- Williams- What did Angela do when Ronnie drove away?
- Coleman- She went back in the house.

Williams- Did you see anyone else leave or enter the house?

Coleman- I saw Angela's friend Connie come out of the house and get in her car and pull away, but as she was leaving, a maroon car pulls in the driveway and a red suv parks in front of the house.

Williams- Do you know who was in the car and the suv?

Coleman- was in his car and 2 other dudes got out of the suv. I didn't know them.

Williams- What did they do when they got out of their cars?

Coleman- They all went in the house.

Williams- So what did you do then after they went in the house?

Coleman- I finished smoking my cigar and making a few more calls on my cell phone.

Williams- Why were you standing outside?

Coleman- My wife doesn't like me to smoke in the house bebecause we have a new born.

Williams- Ok Mr. Coleman, Did you hear anything during the course of the night coming from the Parker resident?

Coleman- No, I went in the house and went straight to bed.

Williams- I'm going to show you some photos and I would like to know if you'd ever saw this t-shirt before?

Coleman- Yea, I've seen it before.

Williams- Where?

Coleman- Angela wears a T-shirt like that all the time.

Williams- Are you sure?

Coleman- Yea, I'm sure.

Williams- Mr. Coleman, is there anything else you can tell us today about this case?

Coleman- Yea, I believe had something to do with Angela's murder.
