4. Ashley Strickland, B/F, Parker's neighbor, Strickland gave this typed and recorded interview on 8/20/97

Det. McCann- Ms. Strickland, what can you tell us today about the Angela Parker murder?

Strickland- Not much.

McCann- Did you see anything on the morning of the 21st of July, between the hours of 2:30am and 3:30am?

Strickland- Yes, I was standing in my kitchen washing dishes when I looked out the window and saw 3 men carrying furniture out of Angela's house and loading it all up in a red suv. Angela and [REDACTED]

McCann- Did you recognize the other two men who were loading up the furniture?

Strickland- Nah, I never seen them before.

McCann- So you said that [REDACTED] was taking Angela's furniture?

Strickland- Yea, [REDACTED] was taking it and the [REDACTED] men were helping [REDACTED] the 2 men drove away with the furniture loaded down in the suv.

McCann- Were Angela and [REDACTED] still arguing when the 2 men drove away?

Strickland- Yea, Daron slapped Angela and pulled her back into the house.

McCann- Why didn't you call the police when he hit her?

Strickland- Because they fight all the time, and I don't think anything of it, but when I woke up and found out that she was dead, I felt bad and scared because I could called police.

McCann- Ms. Strickland I'm about to show you some pictures and tell if you recognize this T-shirt?



Strickland- Yea, this shirt I recognize it.

McCann- Be advised that the witness has identified the gray t-shirt taht was found behind the victim's! washing machine, Where have you seen this T-shirt in this picture?

Strickland- It's just like the one Angela was wearing the night she was killed.

McCann- Are you sure?

Strickland- Im very sure, because she wears this shirt all the time.

McCann- Is there anything else you could tell us that could help us in this investigation?

Strickland- No, that's all detective.
