I arrived on the scene at 132 Foote Drive in Braxton, MS, and was greeted by Captain Oliver and MSGT Feazell (MBI), who was inside of the residence conducting an interview.</i> <i>I was advised that Mr. Damien Cameron had broken into a neighbor's home, and the Rankin County Sheriff's Department was alerted and responded to the scene. Once on scene, it was advised that Mr. Cameron fled</i>

from the officers, and he collapsed in the process of fleeing. Mr. Cameron was taken to Simpson General Hospital in Mendenhall, MS, with his mother, [REDACTED], and his grandmother, [REDACTED], also going to the hospital to check on him. I was advised by Captain Oliver to head to the hospital and to speak with the mother and grandmother about what had taken place that evening.

On July 26, 2021, at approximately 11:15 pm, I spoke with [REDACTED], the mother of Damien Cameron, and she stated that she witnessed when her son saw the Rankin County Deputy start to approach him, and that's when he ran towards his grandmother's house in an attempt to avoid the deputy. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that after a scuffle outside the house between her son and the deputy, the deputy tased her son two or three times while he was attempting to enter the back door of the house, and that's when he fell to the floor at the rear door entry. She stated her son then ran into the house into the bedroom, and the deputy and his colleague ran in behind him, and they wrestled on the floor until eventually, Mr. Cameron was handcuffed. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that her son kept saying that he couldn't breathe and was thirsty. She stated that he also continuously kept saying that he couldn't breathe. She stated that once her son was put in the back of the patrol car, the deputies went back into the residence to retrieve the taser. Once the deputies went back to his vehicle to check on Mr. Cameron, he was unresponsive. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that the officer and his colleague began performing CPR on her son. Eventually, an ambulance arrived on the scene and transported him to Simpson General Hospital. On July 27, 2021, at approximately 11:37pm, I spoke with [REDACTED] the grandmother of Damien Cameron. She stated that she saw when Mr. Cameron was tased two or three times at the back door by the Rankin County Deputy and fell to the ground. She stated that he then ran into the bedroom to get away from the deputies, and the deputies ran behind him. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that once her grandson was handcuffed, he kept saying that he couldn't breathe and that he needed some water. She stated that one of the deputies was using a lot of profanity and wouldn't give Mr. Cameron any water. She stated that while the deputies were walking Mr. Cameron to his patrol car, he kept saying that he couldn't breathe. She also stated that once the deputies put him in the patrol car, they went back inside the house to retrieve the taser. Once they returned to the car, she stated that the deputy asked if he had a medical history. She told him, no, and that's when she saw that he was unresponsive. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that the officers performed CPR on him until an ambulance arrived and transported him to Simpson General Hospital.

On July 28, 2021, at approximately 4:34 pm, I was contacted by Rankin County Coroner David Ruth advising me that the Medical Examiner asked if I could provide them with one or both strips from the tasers if used. On August 2, 2021, at approximately 11:30am, I received the training records for the involved officers.

On Monday, July 26, 2021, at approximately 8:23 p.m., I responded to 147 Foote Drive, Braxton, Mississippi, concerning an In-Custody Death. The deceased in that incident was Damien Cameron (CAMERON). The involved deputies were Hunter Elward (ELWARD), [REDACTED] and Luke Stickman (STICKMAN), [REDACTED], of the Rankin County Sheriff Office (RCSO).

On scene, I learned that CAMERON had been accuse of burglarizing the residence of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] residence is located at 132 Foote Drive, Braxton, Mississippi. [REDACTED] had contacted RCSO. [REDACTED] is [REDACTED] sister.

ELWARD was dispatch to 132 Foote Drive. ELWARD arrived on scene and spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised ELWARD that CAMERON went inside his home and damaged the house.

ELWARD spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] about CAMERON alleged damage to [REDACTED] home. [REDACTED] escorted ELWARD to 147 Foote Drive. [REDACTED] attempted to handcuff and arrest CAMERON. CAMERON fled behind the house. CAMERON and ELWARD wrestle to the ground. ELWARD attempted to Taser CAMERON. CAMERON ran inside the residence with ELWARD following in behind CAMERON. CAMERON and ELWARD wrestle to the floor of a bedroom. RCSD Luke Stickman (STICKMAN) enter the residence and assist ELWARD handcuffing CAMERON.

ELWARD and STICKMAN walked CAMERON outside to ELWARD's patrol unit. ELWARD and STICKMAN placed CAMERON inside the patrol unit. ELWARD and STICKMAN walked back inside the residence to retrieve the Taser and personal belongings. ELWARD returned to his patrol unit and found CAMERON unresponsive. ELWARD and STICKMAN removed CAMERON from the patrol unit. ELWARD and STICKMAN started performing Life Saving Technics on CAMERON and called for medical assistance.

Pafford Ambulance Service arrived at 147 Foote Drive and transported CAMERON to Simpson General Hospital in Mendenhall, MS.


