

1. Have all the layoffs occurred?

Layoffs are expected to occur between Wednesday and Friday. A total of **86 employees** are affected, including **46 full-time** and **40 part-time** positions.

The reductions impact multiple departments and service areas, including:

- Outpatient Rehab Center (*closing within 15 days*)
 - Cardiac Rehab (*closing within 15 days*)
 - After Hours Clinic (*closed immediately*)
 - Wellness Center (*closed immediately*)
 - Additional departments across the hospital with immediate reductions
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2. What are the reasons for the layoffs?

Staffing levels and services are being reduced as the hospital prepares for either a transition of operations to a larger health system or a potential closure.

3. Are these layoffs permanent or temporary?

All layoffs are permanent.

4. Are they effective immediately? If not, what is the timeframe?

Most layoffs are effective immediately. A small number of employees—primarily therapists—will be temporarily retained to support the transition and continuity of care for active patients.

5. Will employees receive severance or other assistance?

The hospital does not have a severance policy in place.

6. How many employees will remain, and what services will continue?

Approximately 425 employees will remain to provide essential services.

7. How many contracted employees (e.g., Aramark) remain? 58.

8. Will any services remain outside the main hospital building?

Yes. Physician clinics will remain open.

9. What will happen to the buildings of closed services?

No decisions have been made. Future use will depend on ongoing negotiations with a larger health system.

10. What about the service level at the ER?

“While some areas of the hospital are being restructured, our Emergency Department remains fully operational, fully staffed, and fully committed to delivering the same high level of care our community depends on—24 hours a day, 7 days a week.”

11. What about the hospital's other service lines?

The following services will remain unchanged:

- Diagnostic liver testing
- Gastroenterology/Endoscopy
- Interventional Radiology
- Laboratory Testing
- Neurology
- Outpatient Cardiopulmonary Diagnostic Testing (*EKG, Pulmonary Function Test, Echocardiogram, EEG, Stress Test, Holter Monitor*)
- Outpatient Infusion Services
- Radiation Oncology
- Radiology Diagnostic Testing (*MRI, CT, Ultrasound, X-Ray, Nuclear Medicine, Mammogram, Bone Density Scan*)
- Retail Pharmacy
- Surgery (*General, Vascular, Orthopedic, ENT*)
- Swing Bed
